

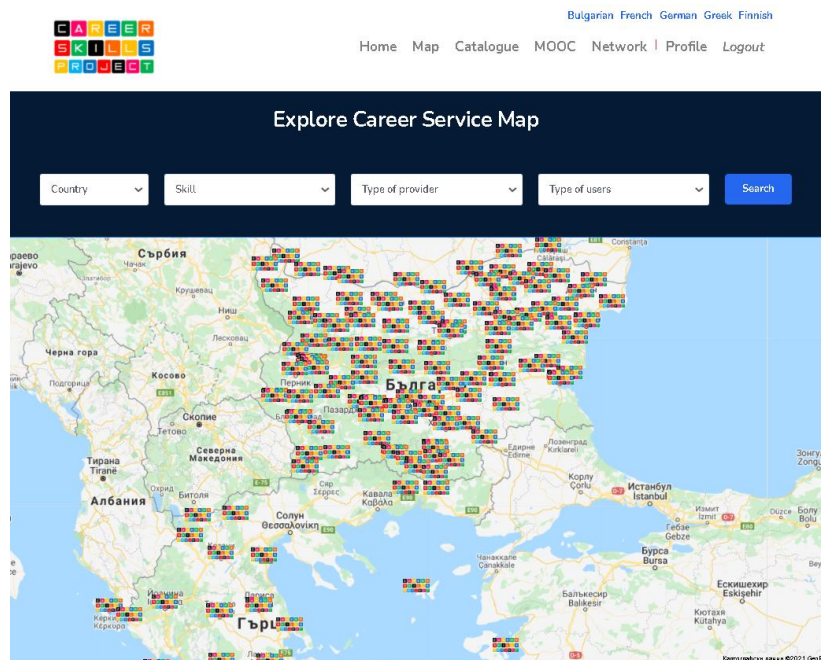

CAREER SKILLS FIELD RESEARCH RESULTS

Between September and November 2020, the project consortium carried out field research and gathered input and feedback from **110 career guidance experts, experienced practitioners and specialist career guidance centres from across Europe.**

The received feedback was generally very positive, regarding all aspects of the Career Skills platform and project outputs. The overall consensus from the participants was that the Career Skills project provides a comprehensive set of tools which complement each other well and address a growing need within the European career guidance sector. The constructive comments helped the consortium make the tools more beneficial for users.

These are some of the most important comments received:

- ❖ "It is very valuable for sharing experiences and good practices."
- ❖ "I find the map extremely necessary, practical and applicable from the point of view of the ever-increasing mobility of employment and training in Europe."
